23	WHEREAS, on May 26, 2020, the Nevada Secretary of State, Securities Division (Division		
24	filed a Complaint (incorporated herein), against Conestoga Settlement Services, LLC, Conestog		
25	International, LLC, Conestoga Trust Services LLC, and Michael Charles McDermott (collectively		
26	Respondents).		

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2020, the Division Administrator issued a Cease and Desist Order 28 against the Respondents based on the contents of that complaint.

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WHEREAS, Respondents timely requested a hearing on the matters set forth in the Cease and Desist Order.

WHEREAS, Respondents have advised the Division of their desire to resolve the issues set forth in the Cease and Desist Order and to comply with the requirements of Nevada's Uniform Securities Act (Act), on the terms specified with this Administrative Consent Order;

WHEREAS, Respondents elect to permanently and expressly waive any right to a hearing and appeal under the Act and/or to seek judicial review under the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 233B, with respect to this Order.

WHEREAS, Respondents neither admit nor deny the allegations recited in the Division's Complaint of May 26, 2020.

Finding the following appropriate and in the public interest, and on the basis of the foregoing, and Respondents' consent to the entry of this Order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Cease and Desist Order issued on May 26, 2020 by the Division Administrator against the Respondents is hereby withdrawn and replaced with this Order.
- 2. Respondents will cease from violating the Act and will comply with said Act.
- 3. Respondents shall not offer any non-exempt unregistered securities in the state of Nevada.
- 4. That any registration exemptions set forth in NRS 90.530(10) and NRS 90.530(11) related to any securities offered by Respondents are hereby revoked. Moreover, prior to offering any security in, into, or from Nevada, whether exempt or not, Respondents shall notify the Division.
- 5. In consideration of Respondents' consent to entry of this Order, the Division will not pursue any further administrative proceedings, including not seeking civil monetary penalties, against Respondents regarding the actions known to the Division as of the date of this Order.
- 6. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as a waiver of the Division's right to investigate and pursue any criminal violations by Respondents.

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- 7. Nothing in this Order is intended to limit or create for third parties any private remedies against Respondents. Furthermore, nothing in this Order is intended to, or shall in any say limit, restrict, or adversely affect Respondents' ability to defend themselves in any civil proceeding brought by any third party and/or criminal prosecution identified in the Complaint filed in INV-061.
- 8. This Order shall be effective as of the date on which it is signed by the Administrator as set forth below.
