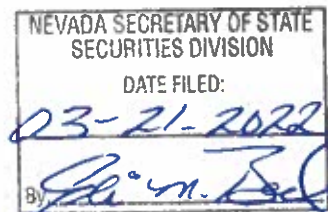

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, RESPONDENT is a Delaware company which also goes by the name of VOXOX;

WHEREAS, the Nevada Securities Division (Division), pursuant to the Administrator's authority under NRS § 90.620, conducted an investigation of Telcentris;

WHEREAS, Respondent violated NRS § 90.460 by offering to sell and selling a security in this State that was neither registered with the Division nor otherwise exempt from registration;

WHEREAS, Respondent violated NRS § 90.310 when one of its representatives transacted business in this State as a sales representative without being licensed or exempt from licensing;

WHEREAS, Respondent has advised the Division of its desire to resolve the above failure to comply with the requirements of Nevada's Uniform Securities Act, on the terms specified within this Administrative Consent Order;

WHEREAS, Respondent elects to permanently and expressly waive any right to a hearing and appeal under the Act and/or to seek judicial review under the Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 233B, with respect to this Order.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator, pursuant to the Act, hereby enters the following:

ORDER

1 Finding the following appropriate and in the public's interest, and on the basis of the
2 foregoing, and Respondent's consent to the entry of this Order,

3 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- 4 1. Respondent will cease from violating the Act and will comply with said Act, including but
5 not limited to ensuring its salesperson register with the State.
- 6 2. Respondent will pay the Nevada Secretary of State a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00
7 due upon signing of the Respondent's consent to entry of this Administrative Order.
- 8 3. Respondent shall pay back Regulation D Notice Filing Fees for the years 2019, 2020, 2021,
9 and 2022, totaling \$1,500.
- 10 4. Amounts submitted under this section shall be remitted to:

- 15 5. In consideration, the Division will take no further enforcement action based upon the
16 circumstances covered by this investigation and Order and close its administrative
17 investigation of the Respondent in connection with the aforementioned activities.
- 18 6. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as a waiver of the Division's right to investigate
19 and pursue any violations by Respondent in connection with other activity not set forth
20 herein.
- 21 7. Nothing in this Order is intended to limit or create for third parties any private remedies
22 against Respondent.
- 23 8. This Order shall be effective as of the date on which it is signed by the Administrator as set
24 forth below.
