YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that, in accordance with the legal authority granted to the Administrator of the Securities Division of the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Nevada ("Administrator"), as promulgated under Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") 90.800, the Administrator hereby issues this SUMMARY ORDER pursuant to NRS 90.420.

YOU ARE HEREBY FURTHER NOTIFIED that you have the right to request, in writing, a hearing on the matters set forth in this SUMMARY ORDER. YOU HAVE FIFTEEN (15) DAYS FROM RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE TO MAIL A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR SUCH A HEARING TO THE ADMINISTRATOR. Should you fail to respond within the fifteen (15) days, this SUMMARY ORDER will become a FINAL ORDER without further action of the Administrator. If you request a hearing, the Administrator will set the matter for hearing at her earliest convenience, but not less than 15 days, nor more than 60 days, after receiving the written request for a hearing. If you request a hearing, you will be notified by Certified Mail of the date, time, and place set for the hearing.

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YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED:

NRS 90.650, Criminal Penalties.

- A person who willfully violates:
 - (a) A provision of this chapter, except NRS 90.600, or who violates NRS 90.600 knowing that the statement made is false or misleading in any material respect;
 - (b) A regulation adopted pursuant to this chapter; or

(c) An order denying, suspending, or revoking the effectiveness of registration or an order to cease and desist issued by the Administrator pursuant to this chapter,

is guilty of a category B felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a minimum term of not less than 1 year and a maximum term of not more than 20 years, or by a fine of not more than \$500,000, or by both fine and imprisonment, for each violation. In addition to any other penalty, the court shall order the person to pay restitution and may order the person to repay the costs of investigation and prosecution incurred by the Division and the Office of the Attorney General. If the violation was committed against an older person or vulnerable person, any restitution and costs of investigation and prosecution imposed by the court must be in an amount equal to twice the amount that would otherwise have been imposed by the court. Money recovered for reimbursement of the costs of investigation and prosecution must be deposited in the State General Fund for credit to the Secretary of State's Operating General Fund Budget Account.

- 2. A person convicted of violating a regulation or order under this chapter may be fined, but must not be imprisoned, if the person proves lack of knowledge of the regulation or order.
- 3. This chapter does not limit the power of the State to punish a person for conduct which constitutes a crime under other law.
- 4. As used in this section:
 - (a) "Older person" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 200.5092.
 - (b) "Vulnerable person" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 200.5092.

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SUMMARY ORDER BARRING LICENSEE FROM SECURITIES INDUSTRY PURSUANT TO NRS 90.420

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Administrator has reviewed the attached Complaint for Summary Order and Final Order Barring Licensee from Securities Industry ("Complaint"), and for the limited purpose of this Summary Order barring Brandon Carl Rudolph ("Respondent") from association with a licensed broker-dealer or investment adviser, the Administrator accepts all factual allegations set forth in the Complaint as true and incorporates such factual allegations herein.
- 2. Based upon the allegations contained in the Complaint, the Administrator finds that a Summary Order barring Respondent from association with a licensed broker-dealer or investment adviser is in the public interest and is necessary to protect the public from potential financial harm.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 3. Barring Respondent from association with a licensed broker-dealer or investment adviser is in the public interest.
- 4. Within the last five (5) years, Respondent is or has been the subject of a suspension or expulsion from membership in or association with a member of a self-regulatory organization pursuant to NRS 90.420(1)(g)(2).
- 5. Within the last five (5) years, Respondent is or has been subject to an order by a self-regulatory organization prohibiting him from serving in any capacity within a business or organization which is a member of a self-regulatory organization pursuant to NRS 90.420(1)(g)(3).
- 6. Respondent has engaged in unethical or dishonest practices in the securities business pursuant to NRS 90.420(1)(h) through his failure to comply with applicable provisions of applicable rules of conduct or ethical standards promulgated by a self-regulatory organization pursuant to NAC 90.327.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Administrator hereby BARS Respondent Brandon Carl Rudolph from association with a licensed broker-dealer or investment adviser in the State of Nevada.
