NRS 293.285

When a registered voter appears to vote, an election board officer in charge of the roster shall verify the signature of the registered voter in the manner set forth in NRS 293.277. If an election board official has determined that the provided signature does not match, the voter may use one of the options listed below as an alternative method of verification.
