DEFAULT JUDGMENT

Upon application by Plaintiff Secretary of State, by and through counsel, Adam Paul Laxalt, Attorney General for the State of Nevada, and Lori M. Story, Senior Deputy Attorney General, for entry of a Default Judgment in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant, Michelle De La Torre, an individual, currently doing business as American's Services, and having been fully apprised of the facts, the Court finds as follows.


The Defendant was personally served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint by personal service on June 22, 2015. More than 20 days have elapsed since said service and, despite being granted an extension of time to August 14, 2015, to answer or comply, the Defendant has done neither. Defendant continues to conduct business as a document preparation service without the necessary registration and bond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Default Judgment shall be entered against Defendant Michelle De la Torre as set forth below.

1. The Defendant is hereby enjoined from conducting the business of document preparation including, without limitation, assisting any client in a legal matter by preparing or completing any pleading, application, or other document, translating answers to questions posed in documents, securing supporting documentation in connection with a legal matter or submitting completed documents on behalf of the


1 client for compensation as contemplated by NRS Chapter 240A.  
2 2. Defendant is subject to and is ordered to pay to Plaintiff civil penalties pursuant to  
3 NRS 240A.280 in the amount of \$16,000, assessed at \$1,000 for each of the  
4 sixteen months Defendant has conducted business as a document preparation  
5 service without being properly registered and bonded as required by NRS Chapter  
6 240A.  
7 3. Plaintiff is further awarded and Defendant is ordered to pay Plaintiff's attorneys' fees  
8 in the amount of \$2,115.00 and costs in the amount of \$44.50.  
9 Full payment of the civil penalties, attorneys' fees and costs, is due 30 days after entry  
10 of this Order and Judgment.
