PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the State of Nevada, Office of the Secretary of State finds that you are in violation of Nevada Revised Statutes NRS 240A as set out with specificity in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

You are hereby directed and ordered to immediately **CEASE AND DESIST** from operating as a Document Preparation Service.

Be advised, if you fail to comply with this Cease and Desist Order, the Secretary of State may refuse to renew your registration and may pursue an administrative hearing to suspend or revoke your registration.

Be advised a civil action may be filed against you as set forth in NRS 240A.280 which may include, without limitation, the imposition of a civil penalty in an amount up to \$5,000 for each violation and attorneys' fees.

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1 Be advised that any willful violation of this Cease and Desist Order may subject
2 you to prosecution and criminal penalties pursuant to NRS 240A.290.

2 FACTS AND RATIONALE FOR CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

3 TO: UNIWIDE MANAGEMENT

4 Case No. DE20191001-005

5 The State of Nevada, Office of the Secretary of State, finds that you violated
6 NRS 240A as follows:

- 7 1. On 3/7/2019, the Office of the Secretary of State, Document Preparation Services
8 Program, mailed Dominador P. Tagacay a notice regarding "Prohibited Terms"
9 use in business name "Uniwide Paralegal Services", pursuant to NRS 240A.240
10 (1) (c). The notice advised Mr. Tagacay that you needed to correct your business
11 name on your Nevada Sole Proprietor Business License and provide proof as a
12 requirement of your renewal registration. You corrected, provided proof of
13 business name change to "Uniwide Management" and on 3/29/2019, your
14 renewal registration was approved and certificate issued.
- 15 2. On 10/1/2019, an investigation was opened as you continued to advertise
16 "Uniwide Paralegal Services" on your Facebook page:
17 <https://www.facebook.com/pages/Unlwlde-Paralegal-Services/>.
- 18 3. Your DBA with Clark County "Uniwide Paralegal Services" was and is
19 currently still active until 7/28/2022.
- 20 4. On 5/7/2020, additional information was obtained showing you switched back the
21 business name on your sole proprietor business license from "Uniwide
22 Management" to "Uniwide Paralegal Services" on 1/13/2020.
- 23 5. On 6/4/2020, a Notice of Violation was e-mailed and mailed to you via certified
24 mail, advising you that you had been issued a **SECOND NOTICE** regarding the
25 use of Prohibited Terms as noted in NRS 240A.240 (1) (c) and subsequently an
26 investigation was opened.
- 27 6. In regard to, NRS 240A.240 (1) (d) and (h); on 6/22/2020, the Office of the
28 Secretary of State received your written response to the notice of violation

1 mailed to you 6/4/2020. The response received did not completely address the
2 noted violations, and did not provide proof of the required Written Contract
3 pursuant to NRS 240A.190, Written Disclosure pursuant to NRS 240A.180,
4 Client Receipt pursuant to NRS 240A.230 and proof of corrected Social Media
5 Facebook pages (Uniwide Paralegal Services, Uniwide Management and Tom P.
6 Tagacay) pursuant to NRS240A.150 and NRS240A.240 (1) (c).

7 7. Mr. Tagacay provided the Office of the Secretary of State a Special Power of
8 Attorney that he provides to his clients as proof of the required Contract and
9 Disclosure. This Special Power of Attorney gives Agent named Mr. Tagacay
10 or Uniwide Management "full power and authority to act on behalf of his clients"
11 and is in violation of 240A.240 (1) (h).

12 8. In addition, on the 6/22/2020 written response received, Mr. Tagacay also
13 provided two items of advertising. One appeared to be the front of a "Business
14 Card" and the other, a "2020 Uniwide Management Calendar". Both items
15 included the name of "Atty Ariel C. Manipula, Immigration Lawyer".
16 Mr. Ariel Manipula is not a member of the Nevada State Bar. In researching
17 further, Mr. Manipula is an inactive member of the State Bar of California who
18 resides in the Philippines.

19 9. To date you have failed to comply with the requirements of NRS 240A.180
20 Written Disclosure, NRS 240A.190 Client Written Contract and NRS 240A.230
21 Client Receipt.

22 10. In addition and based on the forgoing, the Office of the Secretary of State finds
23 you in violation of NRS 240A.240 (1)(c), (d) and (h).
